






NCCARE360 Network Partners and Service Episodes over Time






NCCARE360 Percent Increase of Cases and Cases






NCCARE360 Time to Case Closure



The Impact of CARES Act Funding in St. Louis

In eight months \$7.1M dollars were distributed to over 2,900 individuals, keeping them housed during a pandemic.

Increasing collective impact leveraging Unite Us Payments

The pandemic, social upheaval, and long-term housing inequalities led Metro United Way and Unite Us to make a \$1M co-investment in Louisville, KY. Funds were used for CBO capacity building, and rental/mortgage payments and flexible cash assistance for residents.





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
