Dr. Jermane Bond is Director of Research at the Weitzman Institute. Dr. Bond comes to the Weitzman Institute with 20 years of research experience as a social epidemiologist. He is co-founder of Health Equity Analytics Lab (HEAL, LLC) and has recently served as Assistant Research Professor, Department of Prevention & Community Health, Milken Institute School of Public Health, The George Washington University in Washington, D.C. He received his Doctorate in Medical Sociology from Howard University.

Dr. Bond, a public health leader and health equity strategist, has published widely in the areas of maternal and child health disparities, paternal involvement in pregnancy outcomes and men's health. He has served on numerous task forces, editorial and advisory boards, including the Leadership Committee of the Maternal and Child Health Section of the American Public Health Association, the Maternal and Child Health Journal, American Journal of Public Health and the Community Engagement in Genomics Working Group of the Advisory Council for Human Genome Research of the National Institutes of Health's National Human Genomics Research Institute.
