Sara Rosenbaum J.D. is the Emerita Professor of Health Law and Policy and Founding Chair of the Department of Health Policy at George Washington University's Milken Institute School of Public Health. She has devoted her career to health justice for medically underserved populations.

Professor Rosenbaum is a member of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, served on CDC's Director's Advisory Committee and the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practice (ACIP), and was a founding Commissioner of Congress's Medicaid and CHIP Payment and Access Commission (MACPAC), which she chaired from January 2016 through April 2017. She is the recipient of many honors and awards including the National Academy of Medicine's Adam Yarmolinsky Medal, awarded for distinguished service to a member from a discipline outside the health and medical sciences, the American Public Health Association Executive Director Award for Service, and the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health Welch-Rose Award for Lifetime Contributions to the Health of the Public. She is a recipient of GW's Trachtenberg Prize for Research.
