### Overview

**PRIMARY CARE IMPACT AWARD:** organizations, individuals, and teams that have demonstrated excellence in leading an initiative that has resulted in a clear impact on delivery of primary care and specialty care through practice, research, education/training, and/or policy.

March 12, 2025: Award announcement and application period opens
April 12, 2025: Application period closes
May 1, 2025: Winner announced
May 14, 2025: Winner will be honored at the 2025 Weitzman Institute Symposium: Mental Health Matters

# **Eligibility Criteria**

- Nominations may be for individuals, teams and/or organizations.
- Non-profit and for-profit entities are eligible to apply.
- MWHS, including its staff and subsidiary organizations, are *ineligible* to apply.
- Evidence of the dissemination, use of, and impact stemming from the initiative(s) must have occurred within the last five years before the year of nomination.

## **Selection Criteria**

### Each nomination will be evaluated on:

- Quality of work;
- Effectiveness of dissemination and translation approach;
- Evidence of impact on health, health care, and/or patient outcomes; and
- Effort to translate work into policy and/or practice to improve health and healthcare.

### Nomination must include:

A summary describing the initiative, the translation approach, and the impact on the delivery of primary care and specialty care through practice, research, systems transformation and/or training the next generation of health care leaders (no more than 500 words).

The summary should include the following:

- The name(s) and title(s) of the key personnel who conducted the original work.
- The names of any other team members involved in the work, including dissemination and implementation.
- A description of steps taken to disseminate and translate the work. If relevant, the names and roles played by a communications team may also be included.
- The names or descriptions of user(s) of the initiative, who championed change/implementation based on the work.
- A single letter from a principal user(s) of initiative specifically describing the impact of the work on policy and/or practice (no more than 500 words)

• Up to three (3) supporting documents that illustrate the impact (i.e. peer-reviewed publication, legal, regulatory or policy text, system policies or guidelines, media coverage, etc.). Marketing materials are not acceptable.
